ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFFS

(Issued November 3, 2009)

On October 8, 2009, the Utilities Board (Board) issued a final order approving a settlement between Iowa-American Water Company (Iowa-American) and the Consumer Advocate Division of the Department of Justice that addressed all revenue requirement issues in Iowa-American's water rate case, identified as Docket No. RPU-2009-0004. The Board's order also addressed rate equalization issues.

On October 12, 2009, Iowa-American filed proposed compliance tariffs, identified as TF-2009-0201. No objections or responses to the proposed tariffs were filed.

The Board has reviewed the proposed compliance tariffs and finds that they are in substantial compliance with the Board's October 8, 2009, order. The tariffs include a revision to the charge for damage to customer-owned curb stops or curb boxes that was approved in Iowa-American's previous rate case (Docket No. RPU-07-3), but inadvertently omitted from compliance tariffs filed after the final order in that case. Tariff filing TF-2009-0201 will be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Tariff filing TF-2009-0201 is approved, subject to complaint or investigation,
effective as of the date of this order.
