**QWEST COMMUNICATIONS COMPANY D/B/A CENTURYLINK QCC'S
MOTION FOR EXTENSION**

Qwest Communications Company, a Delaware limited liability company doing business as CenturyLink QCC (“CenturyLink”)¹ respectfully moves for an extension of time for the filing of its Response to the Office of Consumer Advocate’s Partial Resistance to Request for Confidential Treatment and Motion to Remove Confidentiality Designations (**OCA’s Partial Resistance**), filed February 20, 2015, and in support states:

1. Counsel for CenturyLink has five complex filings due on February 26, 2015 in Docket Nos. FCU-2012-0019, FCU-2013-0004, FCU-2013-0005, FCU-2013-0006 and FCU-2013-0009. **These five filings all involve CenturyLink’s Response to the Office of Consumer Advocate’s Report in each case and are key to moving these cases forward in a timely manner.**

2. Further, Counsel for CenturyLink is traveling for both personal and business reasons between February 25 through March 6, and will be unable to work on **CenturyLink’s Response to the OCA’s Partial Resistance until her return on March 6,**

2015, **the date that CenturyLink's Response is due for filing.** Counsel believes that a **short delay to the Board's determination related to the grant of confidentiality of the** information and documents filed in this matter will not cause any undue delays in this case; and that the issue of confidentiality should be addressed fully by the parties prior **to the Board's decision.**

3. CenturyLink respectfully requests this Board extend the deadline for **CenturyLink's Response to the OCA's Partial Resistance** for a period of fourteen days, making the filing due on or before March 20, 2015.

WHEREFORE, CenturyLink respectfully requests a fourteen-day extension of **time, making the Responses to the Office of Consumer Advocate's Report due on or** before March 20, 2015.
