




2011 Broadband Deployment Scorecard

Broadband services were available to **89%** of Iowa households as of 12/31/2011

- Availability of service increased from 87.4% to 89.0% during 2011
- ≤ 1.5 Mbps availability decreased from [REDACTED] % to [REDACTED] %
- > 1.5 Mbps and ≤ 6.0 Mbps availability increased slightly from [REDACTED] % to [REDACTED] %
- > 6.0 Mbps and higher speed availability increased from [REDACTED] % to [REDACTED] %

First time broadband service availability was deployed to over 16,000 Iowa households

- Seventy two (72) wire centers experienced broadband speed upgrades. See attached list.

During 2011, CenturyLink invested \$ [REDACTED] on broadband service expansion in Iowa.






2011 Deployment and Spending Trends

% Availability 2011 vs. 2010




Broadband Investment (\$M)




