



2014-2018 Energy-Efficiency Plan

Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL), an Alliant Energy company, began offering energy-efficiency programs in 1992 to its customers in Iowa. In 2012, Iowa ranked 11th in a national state scorecard of energy-efficiency rankings conducted by the American Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy.

That ranking demonstrates the power of partnership between customers and their energy company, as we work together to keep our energy reliable, affordable, and environmentally responsible. IPL's proposed energy-efficiency plan is also a result of that partnership.

On November 30, 2012, IPL filed a new assessment of energy-efficiency potential and a new energy-efficiency plan with the Iowa Utilities Board. The plan includes a variety of programs that help reduce energy use and support our customers in their efforts to save energy and money.

IPL's plan for 2014 through 2018 proposes energy-saving programs for all customer classes. IPL will continue to offer many of the current rebate programs, plus a few enhancements and new additions, including:

- Expanded *Home Energy Assessment* opportunities
- Many energy-efficiency educational opportunities
- Additional program offerings for business and agricultural customers
- Continued expansion of programs for industrial customers

The Iowa Utilities Board will conduct a contested case proceeding to review IPL's application and may modify the company's new plan. The cost of this new plan is shown in the tables in this brochure.
