IPL notes that, in addition to responding to the Board's Additional Information Request, IPL submits with this filing corrections regarding certain numerical input errors, as well as a few additional minor errors, discovered in the November 30, 2012, filing.

IPL's Plan meets the requirements established in §§ 476.6(14) and (16) (2007) of the Code of Iowa and 199 IAC Chapter 35. Iowa Code §476.6(14) requires electric and gas public utilities to offer energy efficiency programs to their customers through an energy efficiency plan, and that the plan, as a whole, be cost effective. In accordance with 199 IAC 35.8, each utility's assessment of potential and accompanying energy efficiency plan shall include the following: 1) assessment of potential and determination of performance measures; and 2) proposed energy efficiency plan, programs, and budget and cost allocations. IPL's Plan was designed to embody these mandates.
