Examples include: end-user revenue derived from local exchange service subscribership, including EAS; end-user revenue derived from tariffed custom calling feature subscribership such as call forwarding; end-user revenue derived from fixed VoIP service subscribership; alternative operator service revenue; and intrastate switched-access revenue or other revenue associated with intrastate transport, origination, or termination. The company's portion of the industry-specific and remainder assessments will be calculated on the basis of this revenue. See Iowa Code § 476.10.
