RE: Notice of Potential High Volume Access Service (“HVAS”) Situation

To Whom It May Concern:

Per IAC 22.14(2)e, Louisa Communications, L.C. (“Louisa”) is notifying all impacted carriers that it reasonably anticipates an upcoming HVAS situation due to an increase in terminating access minutes of use. We anticipate service to commence on or around August 21, 2015 and have assigned the following telephone numbers to this potential HVAS customers: 563-999-2000 to 563-999-2999.

Louisa will file a tariff with the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”), per FCC rules, in which Louisa will reduce its interstate switched access tariff rates to the rates of the price cap LEC in the state with the lowest rates, CenturyLink. Due to FCC access reform, Louisa’s intrastate terminating switched access tariffed rates will mirror Louisa’s interstate switched access tariffed rates; thus, Louisa will be charging the lowest tariffed access rates in the state on this expected traffic.

Due to Louisa’s existing tariff on file, which has been accepted by the Iowa Utilities Board (“IUB”), already con-templates an HVAS situation, Louisa has requested the IUB accept its existing tariff as an access tariff for HVAS.

Per IAC 22.14(2)e, Louisa has also noticed the Iowa Utilities Board.
