CONDITIONAL OBJECTION

The Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA), a Division of the Iowa Department of Justice, submits this Conditional Objection and states:

1. Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL) initially submitted its Regional Transmission Service (RTS) Rider Second Year Compliance filing on November 16, 2012. To correct an error in its estimation of 2013 MISO Schedule 9 transmission expenses, IPL made an Errata Filing on November 30, 2012, in which IPL submitted revised tariff sheets, schedules and workpapers to reflect a corrected calculation of the 2013 RTS factors.
2. OCA needs additional time to complete its review of this filing. OCA proposes to make a filing in the above-referenced matter on before January 14, 2013, concerning the status of its review and if there are any outstanding issues.
