APPLICATION FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT

COMES NOW, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL), and for its request for confidential treatment pursuant to Iowa Code § 22.7(3) and (6) (2013), states as follows:

1. IPL is submitting herein for filing with the Iowa Utilities Board (Board) the Affidavit of Amy G. Wheatley and the attachments thereto (IPL's Additional Information), in response to the Iowa Utilities Board's May 19, 2014, Order Requiring Additional Information. (May 19th Order).

2. IPL is separately filing a portion of its Additional Information that IPL deems to contain confidential materials in the form of a report to a government agency which, if released, would give advantage to competitors and serve no public purpose, pursuant to the requirements of Iowa Code § 22.7(3) and (6).

3. The material subject to this request has been marked as "Confidential," in conspicuous and numerous locations upon the material, and can be found specifically in the following locations:

- Affidavit of Amy G. Wheatley, pages 2, 5 and 6;
- Attachment 1 (AGW-2) to the Affidavit of Amy G. Wheatley, pages 1 and 2; and
- Attachment 2 (AGW-2) to the Affidavit of Amy G. Wheatley.

These documents specifically contain forward looking cost projections related to IPL's revenue requirement, including projected capital expenditures and rate base. This information could be used by IPL's competition to gather market-sensitive information. Disclosure of such information could harm IPL's position in the competitive market to the detriment of its customers.

4. Release of the information could result in the release of commercially sensitive, trade secret information, as well as higher costs to the remaining customers, which furthers no public purpose, pursuant to the requirements of Iowa Code § 22.7(3) and (6).

5. The confidential treatment portion is required in order to preserve the confidential nature of that material to meet the exemption requirements of Iowa Code § 22.7(3) and (6).

6. IPL is submitting an Affidavit in support of its Request for Confidentiality from a responsible corporate officer.

WHEREFORE, IPL respectfully requests that the Board grant its Request for Confidentiality, and that the Board hold confidential the portions of IPL's filing so marked.
